MINISTRY REFLECTION:

Love Breaks Through

Michael and Jessica Pedalino's testimonies are similar stories of abandonment and fear. Jessica struggled with feeling alone and unloved. Michael took the cruel words he heard daily from his alcoholic mother and turned them into bitterness and anger toward God.

But someone instilled a foundation of faith into each of them. For Jessica, that person was her grandfather, a man with his own pain, who taught his granddaughter about the deep love of Jesus. Michael's father guided him to Jesus, but when he died after a long illness, his son disconnected even further from a God who did not seem trustworthy.

Michael's brother and sister-in-law, Carlo and Kate, persistently invited them to church. When they finally came, our church family welcomed them warmly. God began to break through to Jessica—at first through the music and then through the message of the sermons. She says, "I pleaded, Lord, I need You," and He replied with "How He Loves."

Jessica encouraged her husband to read *The Purpose Driven Life*. Michael says he began to grow more fond of Jesus as he saw his love and mercy at work in his wife. Michael and Jessica were baptized together just before their 11th wedding anniversary. They resolved to teach their children to love God with all their hearts. Today, two of their children have received Jesus as their personal Lord and Savior and are being baptized.

The Pedalinos are forever grateful. "God has placed you in our lives as building blocks of faith," Jessica says of those who reached out to them. They hope that one day God will use their story of pain, fear, and hardships to draw people to himself. They want to do the same for others as was done for them.
