Joy In Tithing

**September 21, 2014** 

I was in seventh grade when my father told my sister and me that he was going to start "paying" us for working at our family's clothing store. This promotion had several functions, but was primarily designed to begin to teach us responsibility with money by having us write our own tuition checks for school. Another part of the conversation that day was that we would be tithing. Up to that point, we had not received an allowance or other regular "income" and just put odd change in offering envelopes on Sundays. Tithing was new. So was being "paid," so beginning both together was a wise way to introduce the practice.

And that was it. I began tithing and have never ceased. While I have not always had what I wanted. God has always provided what I needed even when I wasn't sure how that was going to work out. There have been occasions when I got behind for some reason and it did not appear there was enough money, but upon catching up, there was more than enough. God's economy sometimes seems counter-intuitive, but on the other side of the situation always proves to be the best course.

These days there's a joy in tithing and an anticipation of getting to return to God a portion of what He has so generously provided. I think these are, in part, a product of a long history of tithing introduced by my earthly father to honor and obey my heavenly One. I am grateful to both.
