a glimpse of God at work in our midst The Gospel—Living and Effective

Four times on Wednesday, the pastor shared the truth of the gospel with our VBS children. Each presentation was a little bit different—shaped by the age, attention, and understanding of the group. But the truth remained the same. He told the children that God loves, that people sin, and that Jesus came to bring sinful people back into fellowship with a holy God. I was amazed at the questions the children asked of their pastor.

"How do I open the door to my heart?" "Does God hear me when I pray?" "Why did Jesus have to die? It should have been me.'



These children are listening. Whatever their age or level of understanding, they hear us when we speak and sing about Jesus. And they wonder about it. An entire week of Bible study and worship makes a huge impact.

On Wednesday, the morning of the gospel presentation, one volunteer told our children's minister that she hadn't slept a wink the night before. God kept waking her up to pray for the children. "Children are going to receive Christ today!" she said.

She was right. I told the children who had invited Jesus to be the ruler of their lives that they were now brothers and sisters in Christ. I told them I was their sister, too. Hannah seemed to be really excited about being a part of the family of God. Aidan told me I was much too old to be his sister. I smiled and said that even the pastor was his brother now. He looked skeptical on that one, but still managed a shy, "Hello Bro!"

Please continue to pray for the 380 children who attended VBS/CAC this week. God's Word continues to work long after it has been sown. He has a plan for each of their lives!
